Karen M. Miller, formerly of Poulsbo, died Nov. 28. She was 69.

Miller was born Oct. 29, 1940, in Seattle. She grew up in Seattle and Poulsbo, graduating from King's Garden High School in North Seattle.

She married Duane Miller on Nov. 28, 1958. After moving to Scotts Bluff, Neb., The couple both earned bachelor's degrees from Kearney College. Miller also earned a master's from the University of Nebraska. Over the years Miller worked for Burlington Northern Railroad, Timberlands, FECO Property, and taught school.
